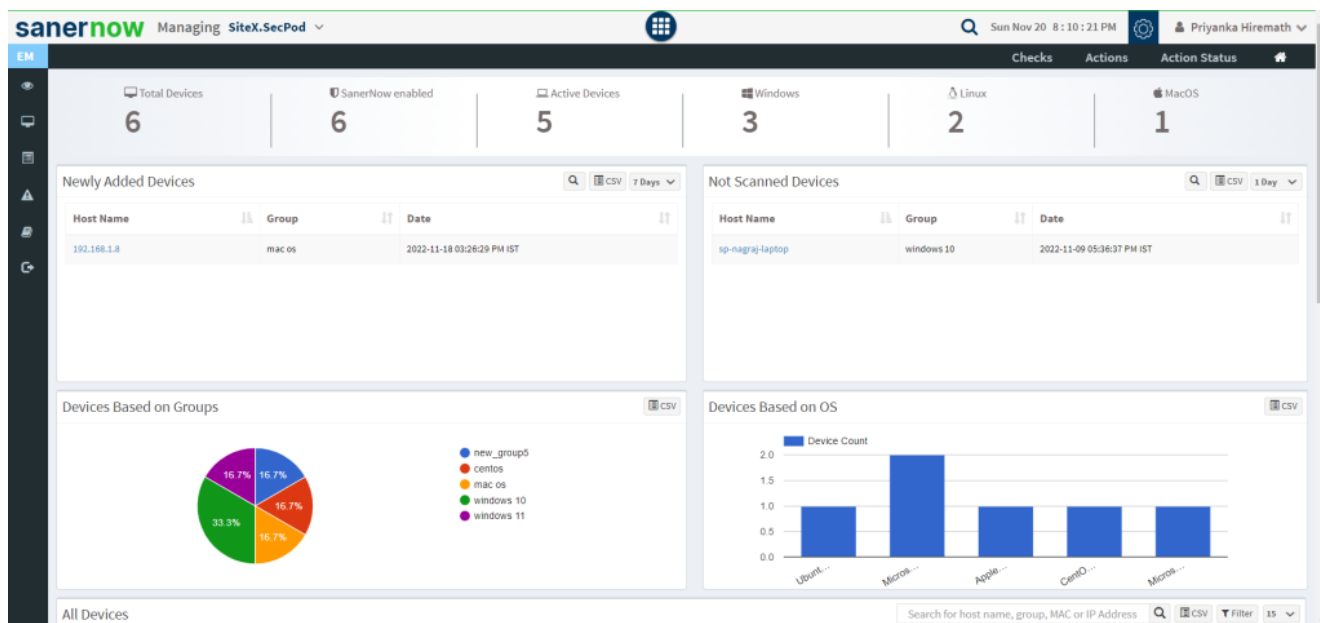


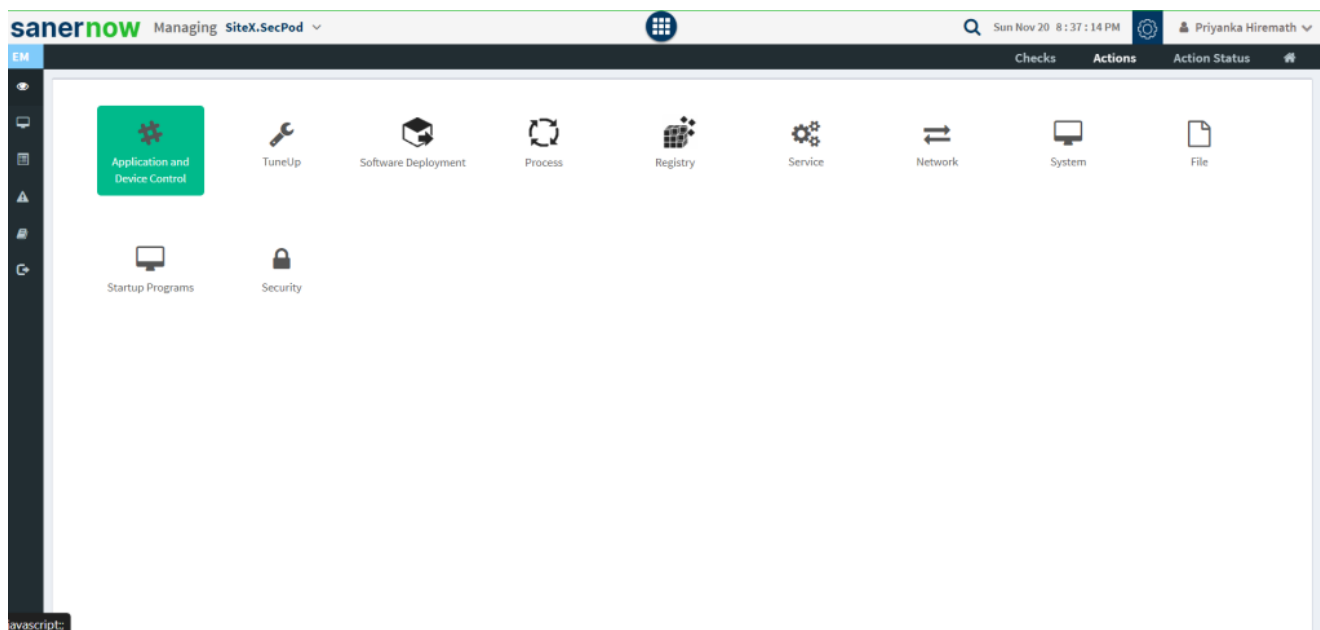
How to enable/disable devices in SanerNow?

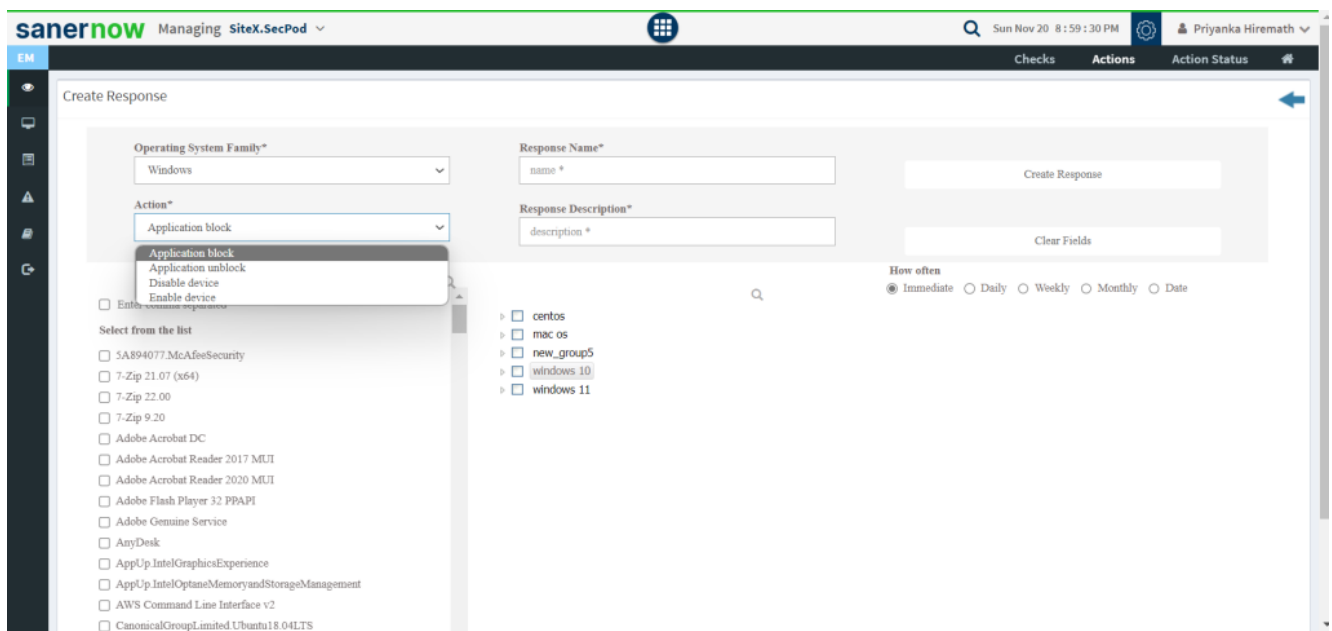

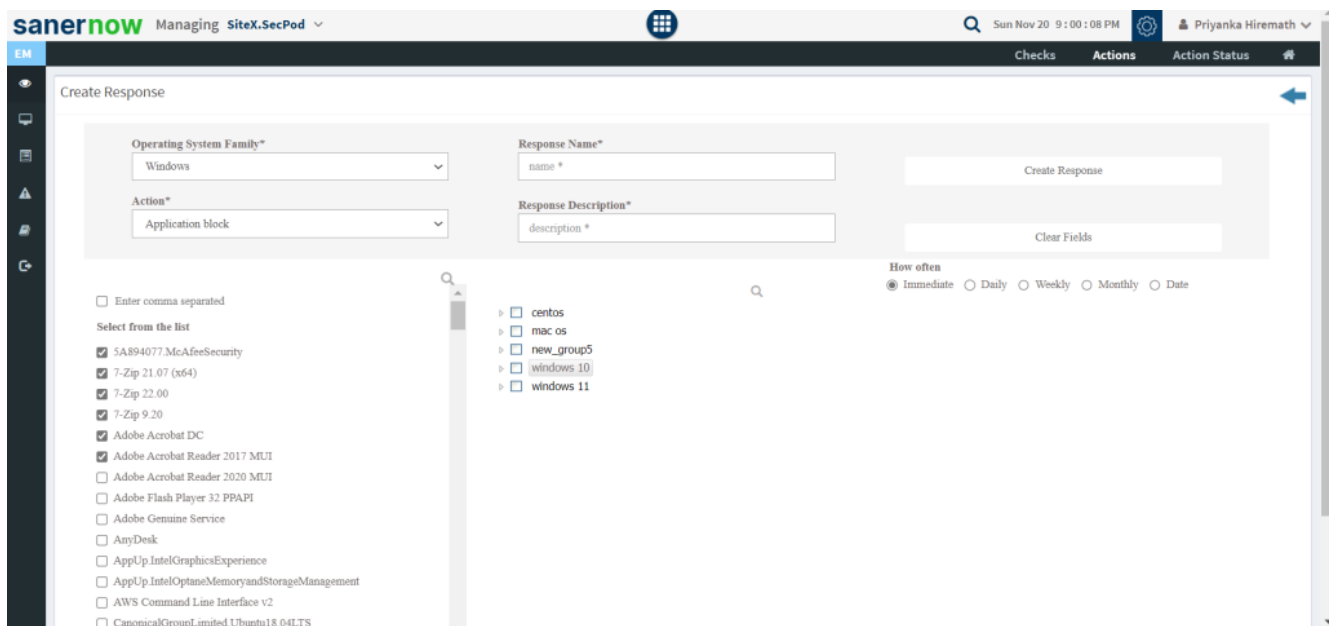
