

How to manage excluded patches in SanerNow?

SanerNow allows excluding both security patches and non-security patches that are not applicable to the environment. As these excluded patches do not show up on the dashboard until the completion of policy duration or until the policy is deleted, you can manage them in the Exclusion section.

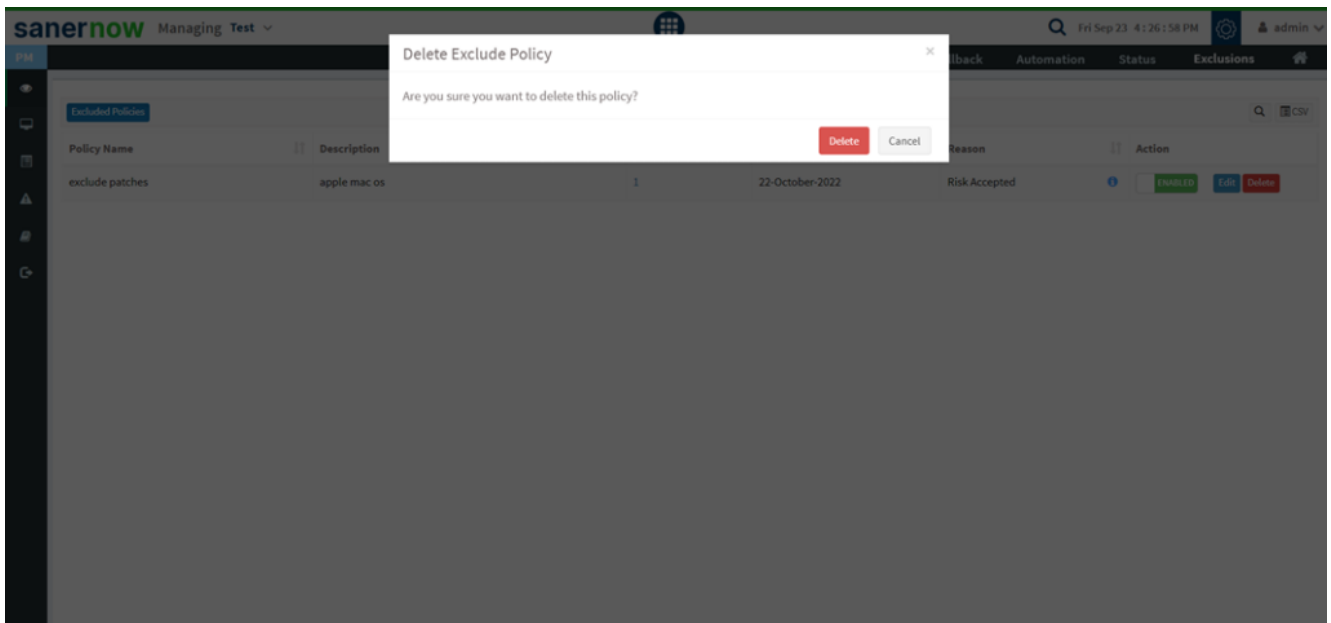
1. Go to **Exclusion** in Patch management, you can view all the excluded policies, edit policies, and delete them from the exclusion list.
2. To edit policies, click on **Edit** in the **Action section** and fill up all the required policy details in Exclude Item(s) window.
